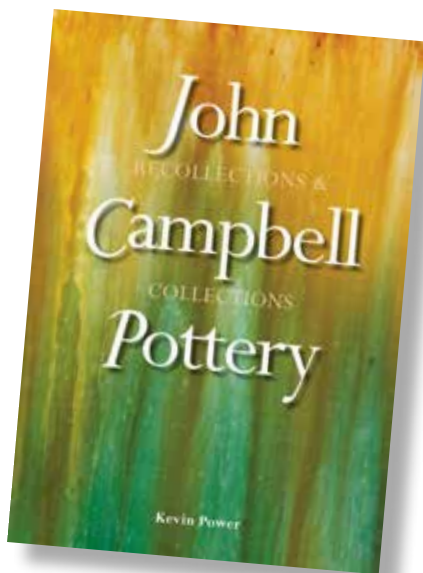


Book Release
